The Department is seeking to develop a regional, rural and remote aged care policy framework and workplan, to outline its priorities in tackling service delivery challenges outside the major cities.

The aim is to improve support for accessible, safe and quality aged care services, regardless of where a person lives.

The department is keen to meet any interested people or groups from the Bowraville community to discuss local challenges, particularly in relation to aged care. The aim is to better understand local preferences for aged care services, and any existing barriers and gaps, and learn about any innovative and place-based solutions to address these gaps and help meet local needs.

The community meeting will be an opportunity to discuss these issues with the Department in more detail.
